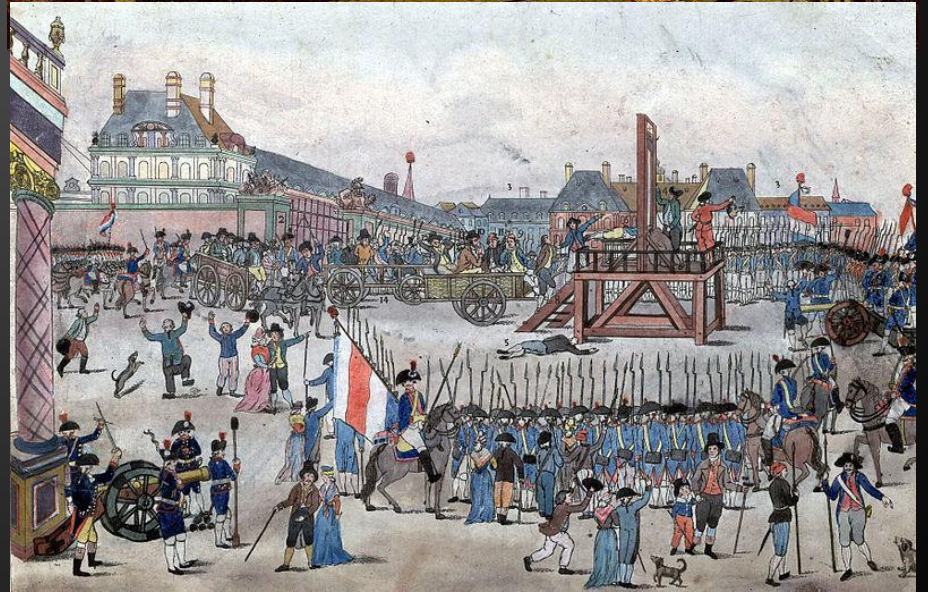
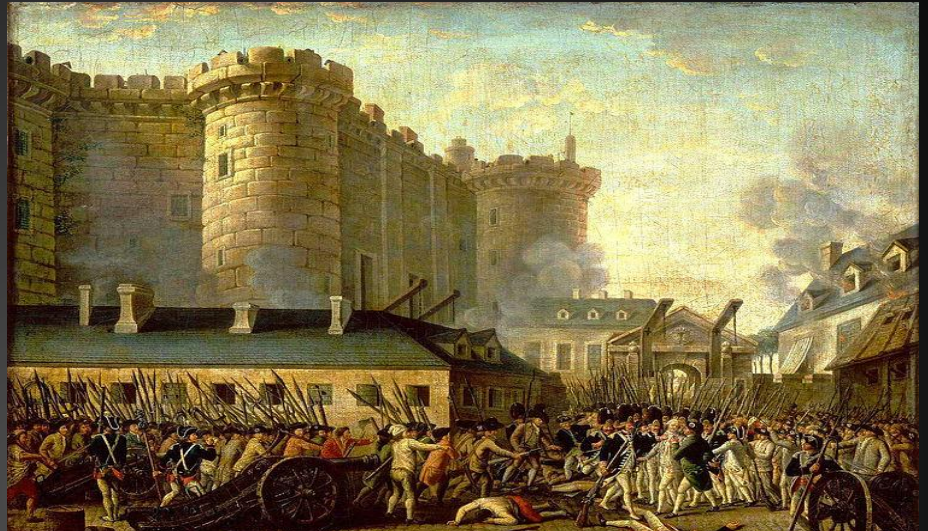
French Revolution

Slave Revolt in Haiti.

1845 Texas Statehood

1836 "Remember the Alamo."

Texas wins independence later that year.

Texas joins the Union, but boundary is still in dispute with Mexico.

Mexico sent troops into the disputed area.

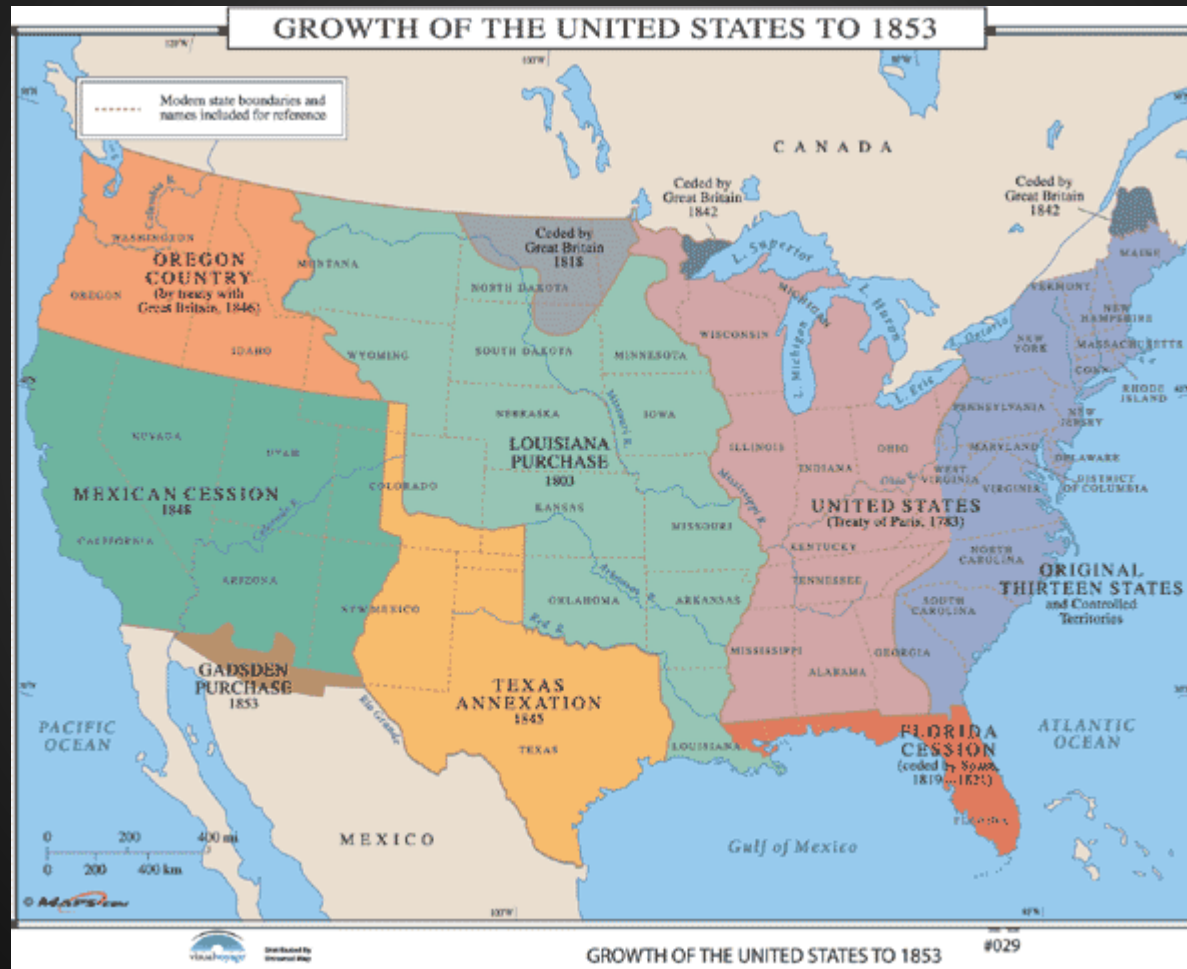
U.S. declared war.
